

Energy Guidelines for Commercial and High-Rise Residential Buildings in Colorado

In January of 1996, a 10-member technical advisory committee convened to produce energy guidelines for commercial and high-rise buildings in Colorado. The committee was comprised of members from the commercial building community -- including architects, mechanical engineers, building owners/managers, lighting engineers, energy managers, building code officials, developers, financiers, electrical contractors, and utility companies.
